



## Leaders In Training (LIT) Agreement

The purpose of this agreement between MLI and the LIT is to effectively carry forth the responsibility of equipping leaders, in a biblical, accountable, orderly and godly manner.

At MLI we realize that there are expectations that an individual has from an institute, and that there are expectations that an institute has for its trainees. The following items are what we see as important regarding the MLI and LIT relationship.

### **The LIT is expected to:**

- 1. Be born again through faith in Christ alone for their salvation, apart from any good works or human merit. (John 1:12, 13; 3:16; Gal. 2:6; Eph 2:8-9; 1 Pet. 1:18-19)*
- 2. Actively walk with the Lord in love and truth; resulting in a biblical love, unity and care for each other. (Eph. 4:1-6; Phil. 2:1-8; Col. 3:12-17)*
- 3. Be respectful of the leadership, practices and ministries of MLI. (Eph 5:15-21; Heb. 13:17; 1 Pet. 5:5)*
- 4. Have a good testimony both inside and outside of the church. (Rom. 13:1-10; Eph. 5:1-14; Tit. 3:1)*
- 5. Agree to foundational Bible teachings of MLI as noted in the MLI Belief Statement. (If you have a difference of belief, please note it on the back of this agreement).*

The leadership of MLI reserves the right to withhold or remove a LIT from the program if they so determine that the individual is not spiritually or doctrinally qualified.

As an LIT I desire to actively participate in this ministry and the ministry of my church; both with my God given talents and gifts. I will seek to encourage other LIT and those in my church in the grace and truth of our Lord Jesus Christ. I understand that as an LIT I will be expected to attend at least 80% of the classes for each course.
